

Tito Boeri

A national of Italy, he is currently professor of economics at Bocconi University, Milan where he is also Dean for Research, and Centennial Professor at London School of Economics. He also acts as Scientific Director of the Fondazione Rodolfo Debenedetti (www.frdb.org). He is research fellow at CEPR, CEP-LSE, IZA and Iger-Bocconi. His field of research is labour economics, redistributive policies and political economics. His papers have been published on the American Economic Review, the Journal of Economic Perspectives, the Journal of the European Economic Association, Economic Policy, the European Economic Review, the Journal of Labour Economics, and the NBER Macroeconomics Annual. He published books with Oxford University Press, MIT Press and Princeton University Press. After obtaining his Ph.D. in economics from New York University, he was senior economist at the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development from 1987 to 1996. He was also consultant to the European Commission, International Monetary Fund, the ILO, the World Bank and the Italian Government. He is the founder of the economic policy watchdog website www.lavoce.info, in the editorial board of www.voxeu.org, and the Scientific Director of the Festival of Economics in Trento.

Ph.D. in Economia ottenuto presso la New York University, Tito Boeri è stato per dieci anni senior economist all'Organizzazione per la Cooperazione e lo Sviluppo Economico (OCSE). E' stato anche consulente del Fondo Monetario Internazionale, della Banca Mondiale, della Commissione Europea, dell'Ufficio Internazionale del Lavoro oltre che del Governo italiano. E' attualmente professore ordinario (con profilo ricerca) presso l'Università Bocconi di Milano, dove ricopre la carica di Prorettore alla Ricerca, e Centennial Professor alla London School of Economics. E' Direttore Scientifico della Fondazione Rodolfo Debenedetti (www.frdb.org). E' inoltre research fellow dell'Innocenzo Gasparini Institute for Economic Research (IGIER Bocconi), del CEPR (Centre for Economic Policy Research), del Centre for Economic Performance di Londra, dell' IZA (Institut zur Zukunft der Arbeit) di Bonn e del Netspar (Network for the Study of Pension and Retirement) di Tillburg.
